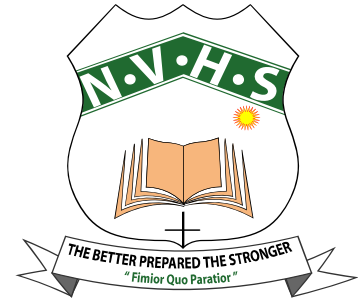

1. Introduction

We thank God for guiding us from the beginning of the term on 15th April 2021 up to the end of the third term. We appreciate teachers who worked tirelessly with our learners throughout the course of this term and all our parents/guardians and sponsors for the support rendered.

2. Annual Speech & Prize Giving Day

The annual Speech and Prize Giving Day ceremony was held on 16th May 2021. On that day our students presented speeches, poems and drama. Thereafter our chief guest Dr Martin Rusanga gave a key note address where he challenged all learners in the school to strive for excellence in their academic work. Students who had excelled in various disciplines both academic and extra-curricular during the course of the 2020/2021 academic year received merit awards.

3. Graduation Day

The 13th Graduation Ceremony was held on 30th May 2021 under the theme “**Stepping into the future.**” Our chief guest was Professor Kelvin Onongha from the Adventist University of Central Africa. On that day 101 students graduated in the Senior 6 class, 71 in the AS/A Level class and 158 in the IGCSE Year 11 class.

4. Commemoration Day

The school held the 27th Commemoration of the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi during the week-end from Friday 11th to Sunday 13th June 2021. Our guest speaker was Elder Stanislus Ruzibiza from Kigali Bilingual Church. On Sunday 13th June 2021 a group of students visited a genocide survivor who lives nearby the school and presented a donation of a bed and linen, clothing, food stuffs and cleaning equipment. The donation also included payment for the house rent for

one year totalling 250.000 Rwf and the survivor was also given cash amounting to 200,000 Rwf. The donations were sourced from the Nu-Vision High School community.

5. Week of Spiritual Emphasis

The week of Spiritual Emphasis for third term was conducted from 17th to 20th June 2021. The theme for the week was **“It is possible by the power of the Holy Spirit.”**
