1. Introduction

With the thorough preparations that were done, we expect our candidates to have done well.

3. Annual Speech & Prize Giving Day

The annual Speech and Prize Giving Day ceremony was held on 14th May 2023. The community leaders thanked the school community for their kindness in helping the widow who is a genocide survivor.
